A SOLID RELATIONSHIP WITH UNDERFLOOR HEATING

A Junckers solid hardwood floor is ideal for use with underfloor heating. The floors are manufactured using a specially developed drying technique which renders them infinitely stable and tolerant of temperature variation. The Clip System installation method enables the floor to be floated over most modern underfloor heating systems where heating pipes are contained within a screed. Alternatively, the system can be placed between battens or joists with the floorboards fixed on top.
